Amateur and Unrated Sections – Game in 65 minutes

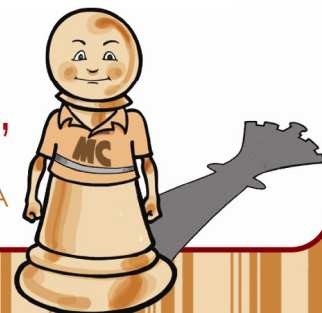
